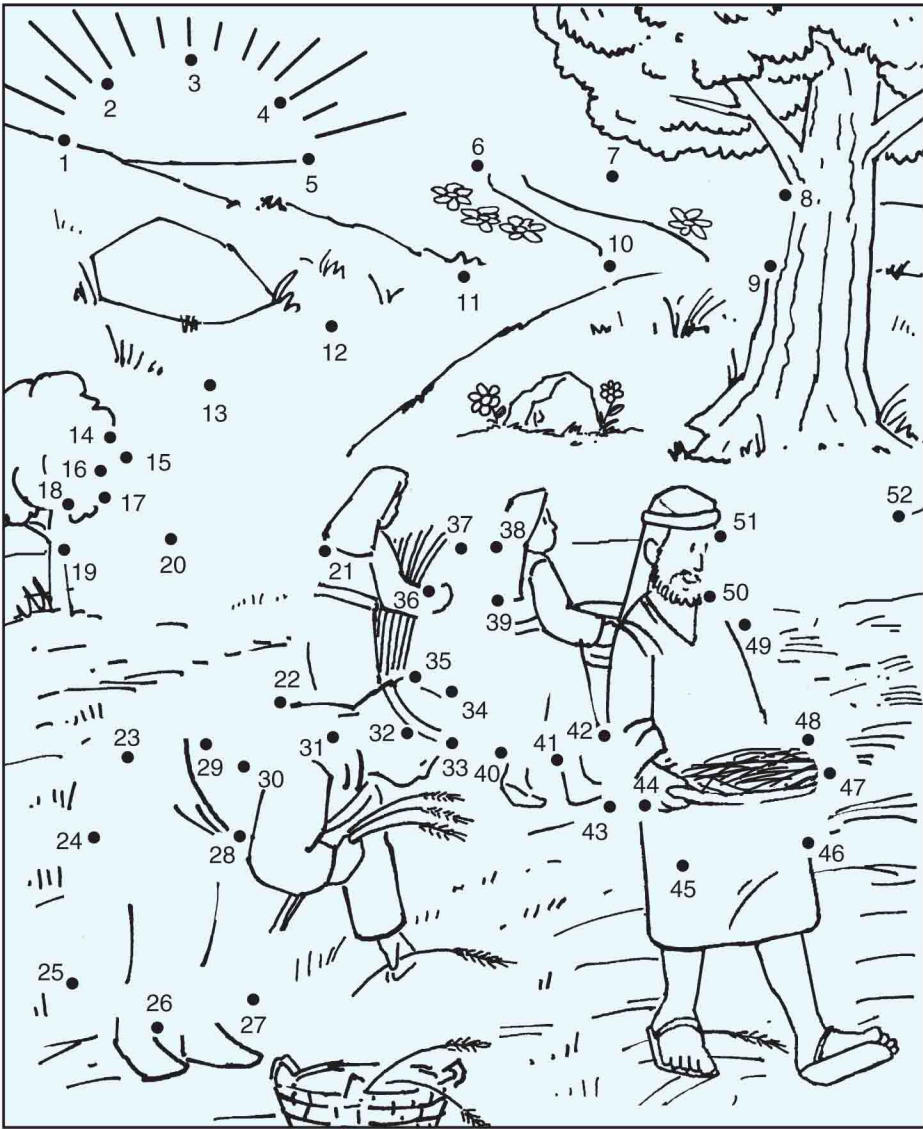




This psalm asks that we may see God's works and His glory, and that His favor may rest upon us.

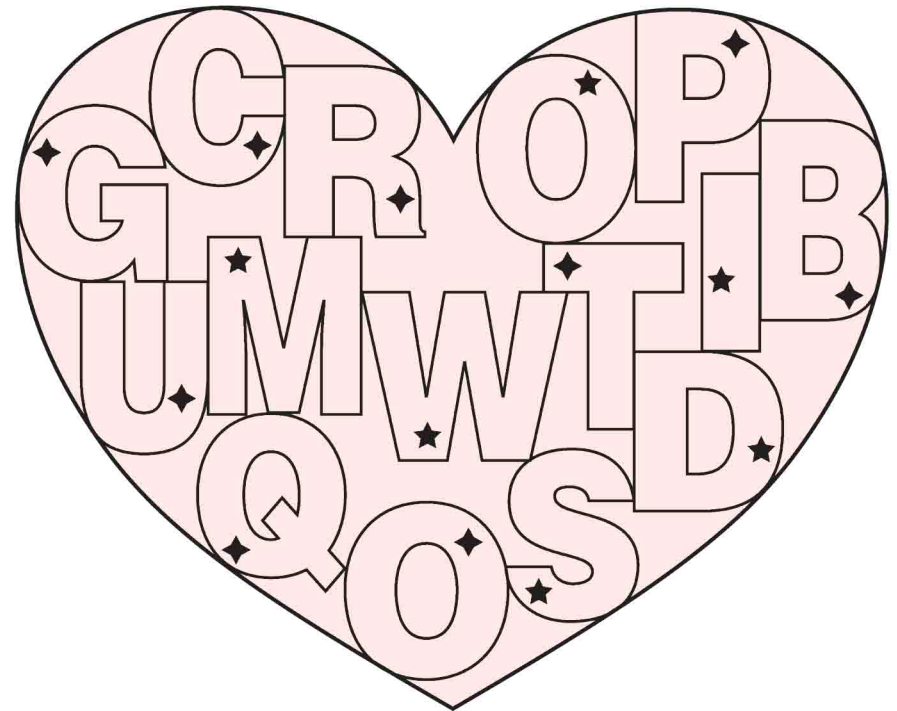

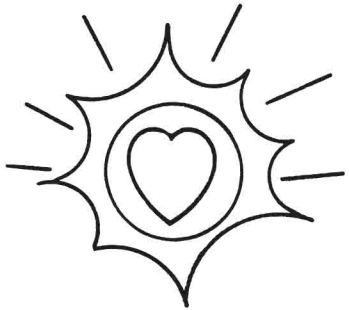
